

1899 : States' / Provinces' own food laws with difference in standards for the same commodity --
Conflicts in inter provincial trade.

1943 : Central Advisory Board for Central Legislation that brings in uniformity throughout the country.


1954 : Central Legislation –







- Protecting health of the consumers


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- Fair trade practices in the food trade,


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- Promote coordination of all food standards all across world.

Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC): Organization




Codex Alimentarius: Structure


General Food Safety Principles: FSSA & Codex


